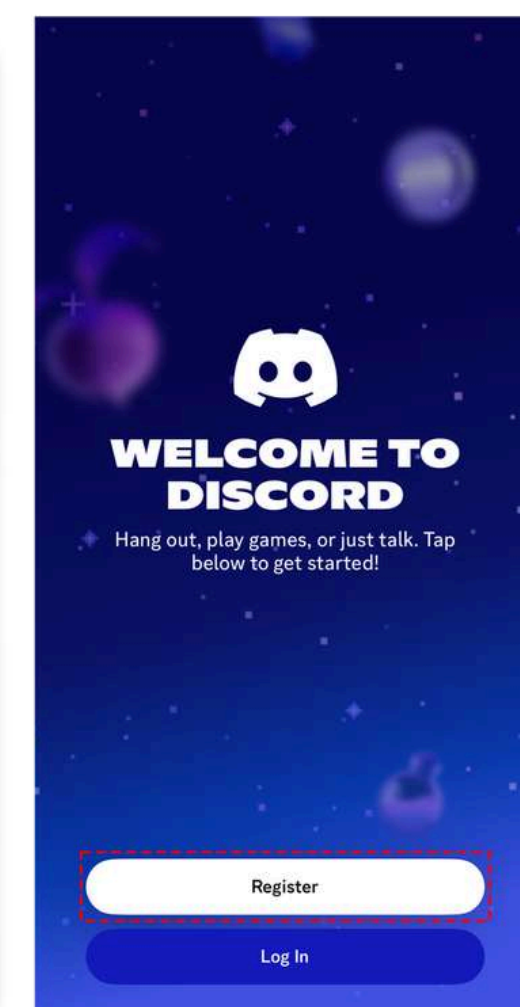
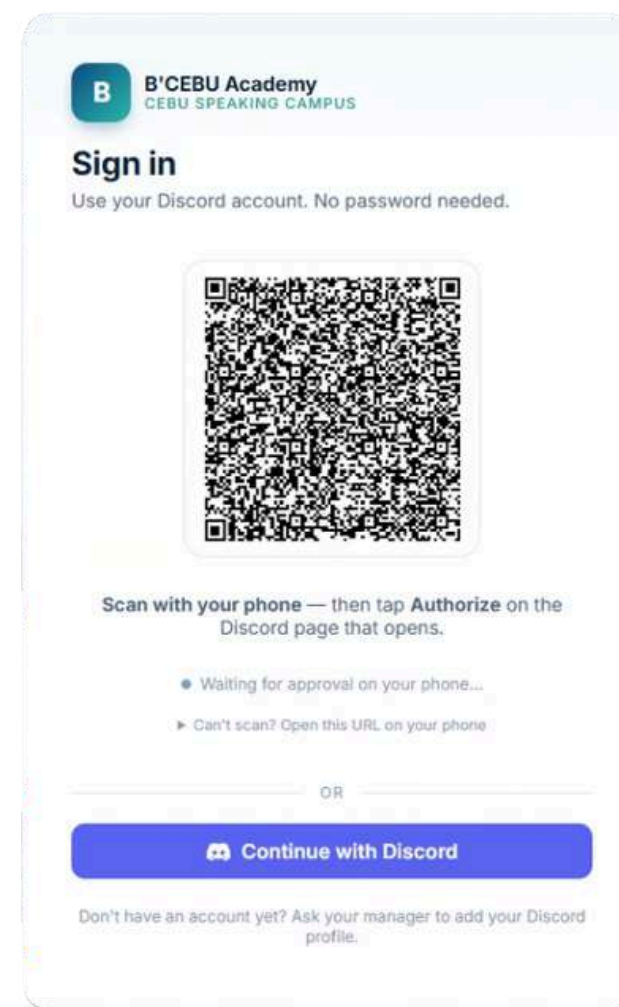
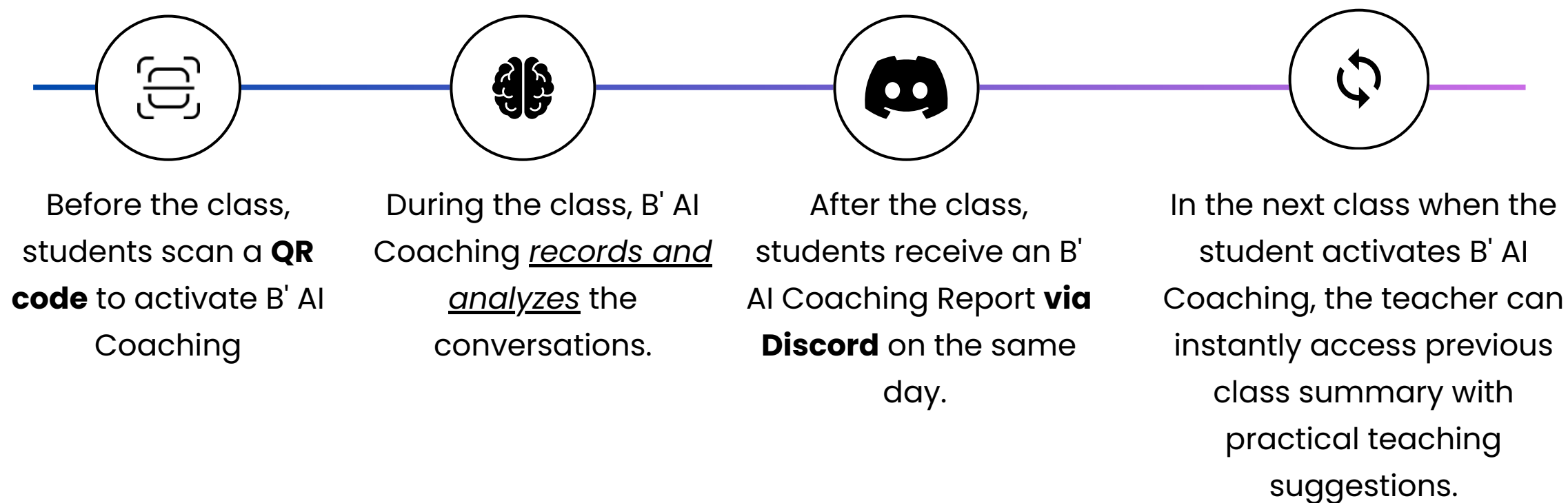

Focus on mastering the use of the present perfect continuous tense to describe ongoing actions that started in the past.

Correction Chain

Offers a transparent, side-by-side comparison of the student's original spoken sentences and the corrected versions. It categorizes specific errors (such as grammar or vocabulary missteps) so learners can easily identify and break fossilized habits.

Next Mission
